If you are being bullied:

Do.....

- Use eye contact and tell them to go away and leave you alone.
- Ignore them and walk away.
- Act as if you do not care about what they say or do.
- Always remember it is NOT your fault and you



Don't.....

- Do what they say.
- Look upset or cry.
- Get angry.
- Hit them back.

What should I do if I see someone being bullied?

- Don't walk away and ignore the bullying.
- Let the bully know what is happening e.g I am going to tell an adult.
- Tell the bully S.T.O.P if it is safe to do so.
- Don't stay silent or the bullying will keep happening.

The Head, Governors and the staff will work together to:-

- Make our school \ place where everyone can feel safe and happy.
- Make sure any bullying is STOPPED.
- We will help everyone get on with each other.
- We believe everyone has the right to be who they are.



What is bullying?

At Nettleworth Infant and Nursery school a bully is someone who hurts someone more than once, by using behaviour that is intended to hurt, frighten or upset another person.



Emotional: Hurting people's feelings, bossing someone around and leaving people out.

Racist: Calling someone racist names.


<u>Physical:</u> Punching, kicking, spitting, pushing, hitting and biting.
