

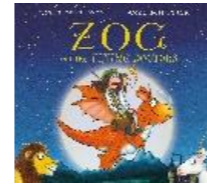
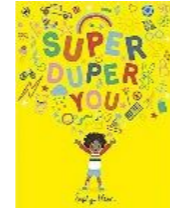
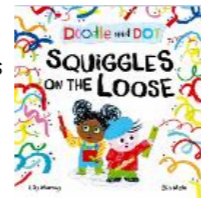

Literacy and Phonics

This half term we will be exploring the four books above and these will all be partnered with an exciting hook. The children will focus on developing a comfortable pencil grip, have a go at making marks and talking about the marks they make. The children will begin to hear the initial sounds in words and will have a go at trying to form some letters that have been learnt in phonics.

The children will learn these sounds in phonics:
s a t p i n m d g o c k c k e u r h b f l



Personal, Social, Emotional Development

The children will be introduced to our rainbow rules and will learn how to follow these with reminders and support.

We will be talking about our feelings lots and supporting the children to recognise their feelings and know how to seek help when needed. Children will be introduced to our zones of regulation and begin to talk about these daily.

Children will be exploring who they are and why they are special.

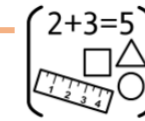


Physical Development

This half term our focus will be on multi skills, knowing how to find space and how to move safely. We will practise moving in different ways such as crawling, hopping, running.

We will be developing the children's independent skills focusing on taking shoes and socks off with support.

Children will take part in daily 'Squiggle me into a Writer' sessions and fun dough disco to develop their strength and large mark making. Children will learn to recognise their name and be able to trace or form letters with support.



Maths

In maths this half term we will be focusing on the numbers zero, one, two and three. We will be developing the children's ability to count to ten and their accuracy when counting amounts up to three.

We will be sorting objects into groups and saying if groups have more or less. The children will be learning some positional language to describe the location of items in the classroom.



Expressive Arts and Design

Our focus in art this half term is drawing. We will learn how to form different lines and shapes. We will practise drawing self-portraits with clear features and describe what we have drawn.

Children will be able to explore the creative area developing their own thoughts and ideas for creations. With adults, support and explicit modelling children will develop basic cutting skills and attachment methods for junk modelling.

In music we will be listening and responding to different songs. The children will learn how to practise finding the pulse in nursery rhymes.



Understanding the World

This half term we will be focusing on talking about our families and events that have happened previously in our children's lives such as birthdays, weddings, christenings. The children will explore their new environment and discuss their favourite areas in school and the classroom. The children will start to explore the similarities and differences between others.

In RE we will be exploring these questions **Which people are special and why? Who are we and how do we belong? Which stories are special and why?**
