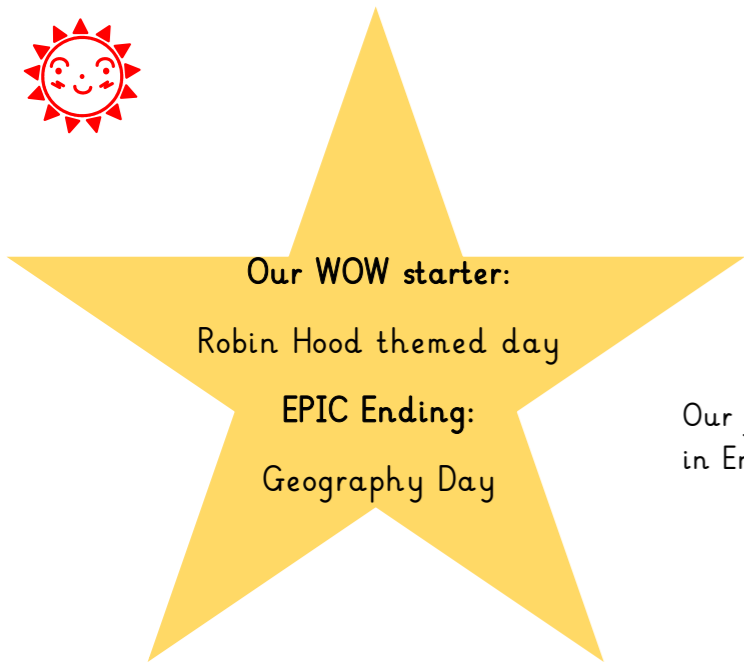


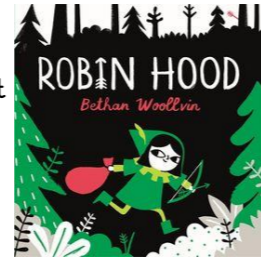

English and Phonics

This half term we will be reading 'Robin Hood' by Bethan Woolvin. We will be learning how to use exclamation marks, question marks, adjectives and so much more.

Science

This half term we will learn the basic parts of the human body and identify which body part associates with which sense (sight, sound, touch, taste, smell). We will also discover why these senses are important in everyday life.

We will be looking at seasonal change and what happens in Summer.



History

This half term our focus will be Robin Hood. We will discover who Robin Hood was and why he was a significant figure in local history. We will also learn about daily life during the medieval period. As part of our visit to Sherwood Forest, we will explore Robin Hood's adventures and legends.



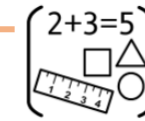
Music

This half term we will be learning the song 'Your Imagination'. We will practise all the skills we've learnt throughout the year.



SCARF

This half term our focus will be 'Growing and Changing'. We will identify things they could do as a baby, a toddler and can do now. We will also name parts of the body that are private and describe ways in which private parts can be kept private.



Maths

In maths this half term, we will be focusing on numbers to 100. We will compare numbers and find one more and one less. We will also look at money and learn how to count in coins.

We will look at time and learn how to tell the time to o'clock and half past.



Computing

This half term our focus will be 'Programming animations'. We will learn the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms by using ScratchJr.



Geography

This half term our focus will be comparing Mansfield to Sherwood Forest. We will look at the similarities and differences between them and use directional language to improve our orienteering skills on our visit to Sherwood Forest.



Religious Education

This half term we will continue to learn about symbols in religious worship and practise. We will look at features of a synagogue and learn about special events that take place in a synagogue.



Art

This half term we will focus on sculpture. We will learn about the artist Giuseppe Archimboldo and create a fruit sculpture using clay.



Physical Education

This half term our focus will be on athletics. We will be getting sports day ready!
