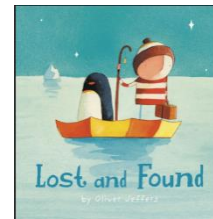

English and Phonics

This half term we will be reading *Lost and Found*. We will focus on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops as we write about the characters.

The children will recap phase 3 sounds in phonics and will learn these phase 5 sounds in phonics: ay ou oy ea



Science

This half term we will be learning about materials. We will be identifying and naming everyday materials and distinguishing between an object and the material from which it is made. We will be describing the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.



History

This half term we will be learning about Rosa Parks and why she is a significant person from the past.



Physical Education

This half term our focus will be on team building and fitness.



Religious Education

This half term our focus question will be 'How do we show care for others and why does it matter?' and we will recognise that people have different beliefs and can still care for one another.

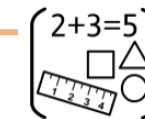


SCARF

Maths

In maths this half term, we will be focusing on numbers to 10. We will be comparing and ordering numbers using the language of less than, greater than and equal to.

We will be learning how to add and subtract numbers to 10 including number bonds and fact families.



Art

This half term our focus in art is drawing. We will be learning about the artist Frida Kahlo.



Geography

This half term we will be looking at the four countries that make up the UK, naming their capital cities and identifying them on a map. We will also be locating Mansfield on a map of England and creating our own aerial maps of school.



Computing

This half term our focus will be 'Technology around us'. We will be identifying a computer and its main parts. The children will learn how to use a mouse and type on a keyboard.

We will talk about how to use technology responsibly.



Music

This half term we will be learning the song 'Hey You!'. We will be learning about how pulse, rhythm and pitch work together.
