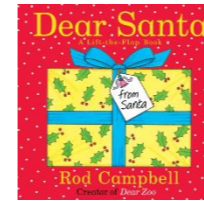
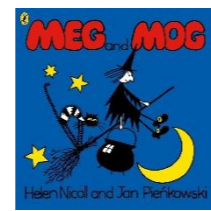

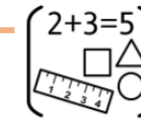

Literacy and Phonics

This half term we will be exploring the four books above and these will all be partnered with an exciting hook. The children will focus on developing their listening during story time and joining in with some familiar rhymes.

The children will begin to show control when mark making and join in with familiar stories. We will also be talking about the characters and learning the key features of books such as the title and author.



Maths

In maths this half term we will be focusing on reciting some number names past 5 and know how to have conversations about numbers. Children will learn how to sort objects using one simple criteria for example colour or size. We will be practising how to show finger numbers up to five.

The children will get to know the daily routines such as finding their picture and putting it on the five frame. Children will help with daily counting to find out how many children are at nursery.



Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This half term we will be learning all about the importance of valuing difference. The children will continue to talk about themselves, their friends and special people in their lives.

We will continue to develop our sharing skills, how to talk to others and recognising emotions. The children will know how to talk to others and begin to know how to ask for help and who can help them.



Expressive Arts and Design

Our focus in art this half term is painting. We will explore making marks with a range of different tools to apply paint.

The children will be encouraged to talk about what they have created and describe parts of their picture.

We will be naming and exploring different colours.

Home Learning Opportunities:

- Sharing stories at home and talking together
- Mark making together- drawing, painting, chalking, colouring
- Exploring and playing outdoors!



Physical Development

This half term we are focusing on dance. The children will learn how to move to different types of music and begin to move rhythmically.

To develop the children's fine motor skills we will continue with lots of funky finger activities. We will be learning how to use one-handed tools like pens, pencils and scissors. We will also start to develop our own personal skills such as using zips and beginning to do some of our own buttons.



Understanding the World

This half term we will be focusing on significant events that have happened during the children's lives. We will be exploring different cultures and compare them to our own.

In RE we will be exploring these questions: **What times are special and why?**
Which stories are special and why?

The children will be sharing the celebrations and traditions they participate in.
