

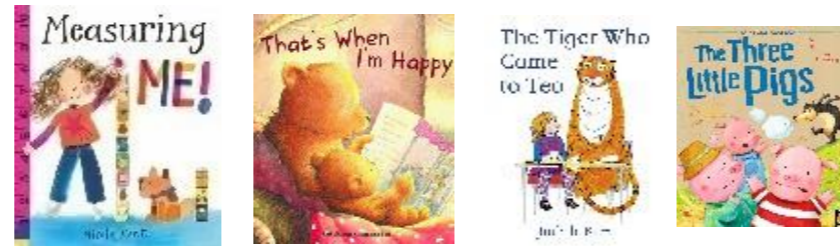

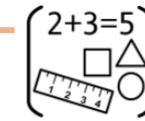


Literacy and Phonics

This half term we will be exploring the four books above and these will all be partnered with an exciting hook. The children will focus on developing their listening during story time and joining in with some familiar rhymes.

The children will begin to make marks on paper and talk about their ideas. The children develop their balance and position for drawing at the table.

The children will learn and join in with our class poem for this half term.



Maths

In maths this half term we will be focusing on learning some number names and to recite these in order.

The children will start to listen to number rhymes songs and begin to join in.

The children will get to know the daily routines such as finding their picture and putting it on the five frame. Children will help with daily counting to find out how many children are at nursery.



Personal, Social, Emotional Development

The children will be introduced to our rainbow rules and will learn how to follow these with reminders and support.

We will be talking about our feelings lots and supporting the children to recognise their feelings and know how to seek help when needed.

The children will be talking about what makes them special and others who are special in their life.



Expressive Arts and Design

Our focus in art this half term is drawing. We will explore making marks with a range of different tools.

The children will begin to draw pictures of people and themselves with increasing detail.

The children will be encouraged to talk about what they have drawn and describe parts of their picture.

Home Learning Opportunities:

- Sharing stories at home and talking together
- Asking children questions about their day at nursery
- Exploring and playing outdoors!



Physical Development

This half term our focus will be on multi skills, knowing how to find space and how to move safely. We will practise moving in different ways such as crawling, hopping, running.

Children will take part in daily 'Squiggle whilst you Wiggle' sessions and fun dough disco to develop their strength and large mark making. Children will learn to recognise their name and be able to trace some letters with support.



Understanding the World

This half term we will be focusing on talking about our families and events that have happened previously in our children's lives such as birthdays, weddings, christenings. The children will explore their new environment and discuss their favourite areas in the classroom.

In RE we will be exploring these questions: **Which people are special and why? Who are we and how do we belong? Which stories are special and why?**
